

## **General Regulations of the SELL Student Games 2016 Tampere**

### **Sports program of SELL2016**

SELL Student Games 2016 Tampere will include following competition events: Athletics, Badminton, Basketball, Chess, Disc Golf, Floorball, Football 7vs7, Futsal, Judo, Orienteering, Powerlifting, Rugby 7vs7, Table tennis, Ultimate Frisbee, Volleyball, Weightlifting and Wrestling (Greco-Roman style).

### **Participation**

XXXII SELL Student Games shall be open for university students with a valid student ID or other document that can prove his/her student status. Students who graduated from a university in 2015 or 2016 can also participate if documents are shown. All participants shall represent their own university. There is no age limit for the participants. In case of team sports, the players of the team must be from the same university. Maximum amounts of athletes/teams per sport will be informed in the regulations of each sport.

### **Registration**

The online registration system can be found on the XXXII SELL Student Games homepage. The process is divided as follows:

#### 1. University registration

- Deadline 15.02.2016

#### 2. Quantitative registration

- Deadline 15.03.2016
- Specification of the number of participants for each sport and accommodation wishes
- Invoice for 50 % of the total cost will be send

#### 3. Individual registration

- Deadline 15.04.2016
- Personal details about each member of the delegation (name, sport, photo, student ID etc.)
- Invoice for remaining 50% of the total cost will be send
- Cancellation of participating without costs has to be done at latest by 15.4.2016
- 50% of the total cost is charged if cancellation is done after 15.4.2016
- Cancellations of individual athletes without costs only with valid medical certificate after 15.4.2016
- Adding a team after 15.04.2016 – only in exceptional cases if agreed by the Organizing Committee

## **Entry fees**

Registration latest by 15.04.2016

- SELL Countries\* 25 €/ person/day
- non SELL Countries 30 €/ person/day

Registration after 15.04.2016:

- SELL countries\* 40 €/ person/day
- non SELL countries 45 €/ person/day

The entry fee includes:

- participation in competition
- catering three times a day (breakfast, lunch, dinner)
- entrance to all competitions, cultural activities and ceremonies
- The entry fee does not include accommodation, travel expenses or insurance

**\*SELL-countries are Finland, Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania.**

## **Accreditation**

When registering in the registration system of SELL Student Games, in all the cases the following data will be collected: name, gender, residence location, date and place of birth, nationality, passport number, university represented, photo and photo of student ID/graduation documents.

Without collecting this personal data, the accreditation procedure could not be carried out.

## **Accommodation**

Floor lodging is offered at the extra price of 5€/person/night. Floor lodging has to be booked with individual registration.

Maximum for floor lodging is 800 places and places will be booked by reservation order in the registration system. If the payments are not done in given deadlines, floor lodging reservation will reset. Organization will take deposit from the teams in floor lodging. Deposit will be returned if rules of the accommodation have been followed by the team.

Hostels and hotels can be reserved by the team. Prices vary depending of the accommodation type, booking date and the amount of the rooms left. SELL Organizing Committee is not responsible for other accommodation than floor lodging.

### **Protests**

All protests regarding the process and execution of competitions or actions of competitors will be solved by the Head Referee in accordance with the laws of the international regulations of that sport event.

If the solution of the Head Referee is not satisfying the protest must be submitted in written form (with 50 €) within half an hour after the end of the competition of game which caused the protest. Protest shall be given to the named sport responsible person at the venue. If protesting succeeds the caution money will be refunded. Later protests shall not be satisfied.

All protests regarding the results must be submitted during the day of the competition in the accreditation center.

All questions and protests shall be answered and the final decision made by the Protest Committee consisting of the Competition Manager, Head Referee of the Sport, responsible person of the Sport and one representative of the Finnish Student Sports Federation. The coaches/ representatives of the teams in question are also obliged to present during the discussion process in addition to the Protest Committee.

### **Insurance and medical service**

Participants must have the appropriate insurance to cover their travel and participation in competitions, as they are not the responsibility of the organizers. The Organizing Committee will ensure the first aid at the competition venues for all accredited persons.

### **Doping Control**

All the participants must be ready for doping control.

### **Privacy policy**

All participants as accredited are informed and agreed that audio, video and pictures taken during SELL Student Games with their face (body) can be published by organizers without participants' personal signature or/and other agreement. If not – please contact Organizing Committee.
